We consider sustainability to be an essential part of good business practice, and as such we are committed to achieving and maintaining a high standard of sustainability in our business.

As part of this commitment, we have established a Sustainability Policy that aims to integrate environmental, social and economic considerations into our business operations.

Carbon reduction:

- Reduce greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions through use of renewable energy across our Sites where available, including solar power.
- Implement sustainable sourcing practices by procuring raw materials responsibly and supporting suppliers who adhere to environmental standards.
- Actively market and encourage the commercial use of 'Green' Steel with our customers (steel with a lower carbon footprint).

Waste management:

- Optimise waste management processes by prioritising recycling steel, re-using packaging and reducing landfill waste.

Recycling Practices:

- Promote steel recycling and reprocessing, ensuring maximum resource efficiency.
- Use of protective paper and banding that enable materials to be reused or recycled.

Monitoring and Reporting:

- Track sustainability performance through key performance indicators (KPIs) and regular internal audits.
- Reporting of energy data via ESOS and SECR
- Annual assessment by EcoVadis (a globally recognised platform that provides sustainability benchmarking ratings for businesses)

Compliance:

- To comply with relevant Legislation
- We are certified to ISO 14001:2015

Employee Engagement:

- Promote awareness to employees on sustainability practices and goals.
- Encourage initiatives from employees and other stakeholders to enhance sustainability performance.

Continual improvement:
